PLEASE REFRAIN FROM VISITING WARD OFFICES

BEFORE HEADING OUT TO YOUR LOCAL WARD OFFICE...

- Remember that you can file a move-out notification and apply for various certificates **online or using mail-in forms**
- If you have to physically come to your local ward or branch office, **make sure to call** them in advance
- Please keep **the number of people** coming to the office **to the absolute minimum**

PREVENTIVE MEASURES AT THE WARD OFFICES

- We have temporarily stopped accepting new applications for the Personal ID Number Cards. You can still apply for this card online or using a mail-in form. Furthermore, we have also extended the application period for fuel expense subsidies and taxi subsidies for the disabled.
- Clear plexiglass splash guards have been installed at various ward office service desks.
